#### General Rules for All Events:

1. **\*NO TOURNAMENT FEES FOR PLAYERS WHO REGISTER BY 2 PM.**
2. **Players must be in the registration line by 2 pm sharp to qualify for the waiver.**
3. **The late entries and re-entries will pay the designated tournament fee.**
4. **Tables are 6-handed. Unofficial final tables are 7-handed.**
5. **The poker shot clock is 30 seconds with three 60-second time banks each day.**
6. **Players at the featured table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Featured tables will have a 30-minute broadcast delay.**
7. **Director will draw the number of hands to play in the final 10 minutes of the day.**
8. **Players must be 21 years of age to participate.**
9. **Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.**
10. **Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.**
11. **This tournament is subject to NRS 463.362.**

### **Poker Masters #01 – \$10K NLH**

**\$10,000 plus \$500\* buy-in**

**Friday, September 7<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm**

1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
3. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
4. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
5. Players will play down to the final 6. Day 2 start time is 12 pm.

### **Poker Masters #02 – \$25K NLH**

**\$25,000 plus \$1,000\* buy-in**

**Saturday, September 8<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm**

1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play Day 2 in the prior event.
2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
4. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
6. Players will play down to the final 6. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

### **Poker Masters #03 – \$25K PLO**

**\$25,000 plus \$1000\* buy-in**

**Sunday, September 9<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm**

1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play Day 2 in the prior event.
2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
4. Players start with 150,000 in tournament chips.
5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
6. Players will play down to the final 6. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

### **Poker Masters #04 – \$10K Triton Hold'em**

**\$10,000 plus \$500\* buy-in**

**Monday, September 10<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm**

1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play Day 2 in the prior event.
2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
4. Players start with 300,000 in tournament chips (three 100K bullets).
5. All bullets must be redeemed by the close of registration.
6. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
7. Players will play down to the final 6. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

### **Poker Masters #05 – \$25K NLH**

\$25,000 plus \$1,000\* buy-in

Tuesday, September 11<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm

1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play Day 2 in the prior event.
2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
4. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
6. Players will play down to the final 6. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

### **Poker Masters #06 – \$50K NLH**

\$50,000 plus \$2,000\* buy-in

Wednesday, September 12<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm

1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play Day 2 in the prior event.
2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
4. Players start with 150,000 in tournament chips.
5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
6. Players will play down to the final 6. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

### **Poker Masters #07 – Main Event**

\$100,000 plus \$3,000\* buy-in

Thursday, September 13<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm

1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play Day 2 in the prior event.
2. This is a three-day event with a single re-entry option.
3. Players may re-enter once through the first 10 levels.
4. Players start with 200,000 in tournament chips.
5. Levels are 60 minutes with a 10-minute break every 2 levels.
6. Players will play 10 levels on Day 1 and Day 2.
7. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.
8. The Director will determine the start time for Day 3.
